

TYPE OF CONTRIBUTION: WHERE TO GO:

GOODS (ARRIVING BY AIR OR SEA)

CUSTOMS CLEARANCE BY THE JAMAICA CUSTOMS AGENCY (JCA) WILL BE REQUIRED FOR ANY ITEMS ARRIVING BY AIR OR SEA.

Special duty-free allowances and tax-free entry have been approved for items consigned to the ODPEM. **Details are:**

TECHNICAL EXPERTS (NON-JAMAICAN **PERSONNEL)**

All donors should check with the Office of Disaster Preparedness and Emergency Management (ODPEM) at donationcoordinationjamaica@odpem.org.jm to ensure that the technical expertise and skills sets are required as a part of the relief effort.

PRE-ARRIVAL CLEARANCE IS REQUIRED FROM THE **PASSPORT, IMMIGRATION AND CITIZENSHIP AGENCY** (PICA).

TECHNICAL EXPERTS (WITH SUPPORT ANIMALS)

APPROVAL MUST BE GRANTED BY THE VETERINARY **SERVICES DIVISION (VSD) BEFORE ARRIVAL IN THE** COUNTRY.

KINDLY NOTE JAMAICA DOES NOT ACCEPT ANIMALS FROM SOME COUNTRIES.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

Pre-Arrival Notification

Email emergencyreliefclearance@jca.gov.jm indicating the following:

- Intended use or purpose of items
- Mode of arrival (air or sea)
- Expected date, time and port of arrival
- Donor name and contact details
- Name of local customs broker
- List of items including description and quantities (N.B. All approvals must be in place for medications, food and chemicals consult your customs broker)

Arrival Documents

- Packing List
- Airway Bill (if arriving by air) or Bill of Laden (if arriving by Sea)
- Invoices (where available)
- Cargo Manifest

**Special Temporary Provisions for Specific Items:

The JCA has temporarily suspended import duty and General Consumption Tax (GCT) on specific goods and items (see list here) being imported in support of the national recovery effort. All other fees and charges remain applicable. the suspension expires November 28, 2025.

Pre-Arrival Notification

Email nmia@pica.gov.jm indicating the following:

- Purpose of trip
- Mode of arrival (air or sea)
- Expected date, time and port of arrival
- Donor name and contact details
- List of all passengers and crew (including full name, nationality, passport number, flight details, passport bio-data page)

Upon Entry

- National passport
- Customs C5 Form (https://enterjamaica.gov.jm)
- Visas waived for personnel arriving for relief and rescue personnel until January 29, 2026

Pre-Arrival Notification (at least 24 hours prior)

Email <u>vsdpermits@moa.gov.jm</u> indicating the following:

- Expected date, time and port of arrival
- Donor name and contact details
- Number of animals and type

In the case of dogs, confirmation that:

o Dog is in good health and free of infectious disease having been examined at least 48 hours prior to arrival

TYPE OF CONTRIBUTION: WHERE TO GO:

TECHNICAL EXPERTS (WITH SUPPORT **ANIMALS) CONT'D**

IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE, APPROVAL BY THE **JAMAICA CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY (JCAA) IS REQUIRED FOR ALL NON-COMMERCIAL FLIGHTS** LANDING IN JAMAICA.

Kindly also note:

- Ground handling arrangements must be made prior to the flight operations to Jamaica
- JCAA is to be copied on communication to ODPEM to include packing list
- On receipt of the compliant application by the JCAA, permits will be granted within an hour
- Expect slotting rules to be applied at the airports to streamline efficient arrival, offloading and departure. This will be managed by the airport operators.
- Flight plans are to be filed at minimum one (1) hour prior to departure from point of origin.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- o Cleared for travel
- o Is microchipped with an ISO-compatible microchip
- o Vaccinated with appropriate inactivated vaccine in the last
- 12 months or 36 months as applicable
- o Post rabies vaccination FAVN titre greater than 0.5IU/ml
- Name of handler travelling with dog
- Health records for each animal

Additional, detailed relevant information will be provided once the email is received by ODPEM.

- Purpose of trip
- Expected date, time and port of arrival
- Donor name and contact details
- Signed letter addressed to the JCAA confirming that the airline will follow the security procedures of its designated local handling agent (that is, the handling agent selected by the operator to assist with airport operations). Kindly revise the security letter submitted.
- Aircraft details and documentation:
 - Air Operator Certificate
 - Operations Specification (Sections A003- Aircraft Authorisation, B050 Authorised areas en route operations, D085- aircraft listing. The digital signature page **must be** included.
 - Certificate of Registration
 - Certificate of Airworthiness
 - Noise Certificate
 - Radio Station Licence
 - Certificate of Insurance

LIST OF DISASTER RELIEF ITEMS FOR THE GENERAL PUBLIC

The Government of Jamaica has approved a 30-day Tax Waiver on specific goods being imported for recovery from Hurricane Melissa by the general public. The details are as follows:

Effective Dates: October 29, 2025 - November 28, 2025.

What is waived: Import Duty (ID) and General Consumption Tax (GCT)

- Wipes
- Cleaning products
- Diapers
- Clothing
- Mattress
- Bed Linens / Bed Pads / Baths Linens
- Toiletries
- Over-the-Counter Drugs
- First Aid Kits/Hygiene Kits
- Kitchen Utensils (Including, non-plastic disposables, pots and pans)
- Garbage bags
- Ply Boards
- Nails
- Zinc
- Tarpaulins
- Generators Not Exceeding 5000Watts (Household Use Only)
- Tents
- Igloos
- Bed Cots
- Sleeping Bags
- Flash Lights
- Basic School Supplies

- Bottled Water
- Disposal Batteries
- Mobile Battery Packs
- Lantern/Lamps
- Solar Flood Lights
- Gloves
- Rain Gear/Coats
- Water Boots
- Buckets/Pans
 (Water Storage Containers)
